

CABIN RULES

Welcome to Alp da Canaa! We wish you a pleasant stay.

There are rules that cannot be written and that every mountain lover knows. They are those of respect, hospitality, and friendship, which we invite you to follow in "our mountains".

Below are some instructions to make your visit and that of other guests easier.

- Beds in the cabin are limited. If you intend to stay overnight, reserve your spot in advance.
- Upon arrival, register your name in the cabin book. By indicating your destination, you can greatly facilitate a possible rescue or search intervention.
- The use of the cabin for hunting purposes is forbidden.
- Help keep the cabin in top condition. Should you cause or see any damage, please notify us as soon as possible (canaa@valledilodano.ch).
- Take off your boots before entering the common room and dorms. The slippers placed at your disposal in the adjacent building are more comfortable.
- It is forbidden to smoke inside. Dogs and other animals are also not allowed indoors.
- Do not bring mattresses, duvets, and pillows outside the dorms.
- In the absence of the custodian, clean up as soon as you have finished cooking, so that other guests may use the kitchen.
- For hygienic reasons, the use of a bed sheet is mandatory. Fold the duvets after use.
- If other guests are present, please respect quiet hours after 10 p.m.
- Use only the toilet. Do not throw waste of any kind in the toilet.
- Biodegradable waste (food remains, etc.) can be thrown into the appropriate compost pit. Glass, cans, and PET purchased in the cabin are to be placed in the recycling bins. Any other garbage must be taken with you.
- Beware of the risk of fire! Before going to bed, make sure the stove doors are closed.
- Before leaving the cabin:
 - Make sure everything is in order (dorms, common room, kitchen, bathroom, and floors are clean, duvets are folded, etc.)
 - Clean the fireplace and stove, and bring any remaining pieces of wood, charcoal, or ashes outside. If necessary, extinguish them with water, and put them in the appropriate pit.
 - Make sure all windows and doors are closed.
 - If you have time, wash and hang up the dishtowels to dry and leave a good supply of wood in the kitchen. You will make guests who comes after you happy!

The cabin relies on the commitment of numerous volunteers. However, your contribution for the overnight stay and any beverages you might consume is essential to cover the costs (wood, gas, water supply, food and drinks, cabin and path maintenance) and ensure a future for Alp da Canaa.
